Highfield Hall, Omdurman Road

1. If you are arriving on Tuesday evening, please go straight to the Halls of Residence. You will need to collect your room key from Reception. Rooms available from 17.00.

Breakfast on Wednesday morning will be at 08.15-08.45 in Highfield Hall Dining Room

2. If you are arriving on Wednesday, please go straight to the registration desk in Garden End of Garden Court and register. It is a short walk to **Highfield Hall**, where you will be staying.

Breakfast on Thursday morning will be at 07.15-08.00 in Highfield Hall Dining Room

Parking will be available either at Highfield Hall or Avenue Campus throughout your stay.

Glen Eyre Complex, Glen Eyre Road

1. If you are arriving on Tuesday evening, please go straight to the Halls of Residence. You will need to collect your room key from main Reception. **(PLEASE ENSURE YOU KEEP HOLD OF YOUR TAXI – AS BEDROOMS ARE SOME DISTANCE FROM RECEPTION)**

2. If you are arriving on Wednesday, please go straight to the registration desk in Garden End of Garden Court, Staff Social Centre, Highfield Campus and register. It is a short walk to **Glen Eyre Complex**, where you will be staying.
