

## **Re: Car Parking for the BRS/BORS conference at Southampton**

Dear delegate

Parking will be a problem, especially on the Wednesday, when the University is holding an open day and will have hundreds of visitors. (We did not know this until it was too late to change the date of the conference).

**There is no parking at the Nuffield Theatre, except for disabled drivers.** The car park as you arrive at the Nuffield is for Theatre staff only and you will be clamped if you park there. There is very limited parking for disabled drivers. Please let us know if you qualify for disabled parking - we will need to give names to the parking attendant.

There is no parking in the roads around the University (it's all residents only), so don't waste time trying.

We have a small number of allocated spaces in the Hampton car park. This is about 7 minutes walk away from the Nuffield Theatre (lectures) and Garden Court (registration, posters, exhibition, catering).

Please note the following:

### **For residential delegates**

If you are staying at one of the halls of residences, please drive directly to your Hall of residence (as notified in your registration confirmation letter – if you're no longer sure which hall you are in please contact Elaine Orchard on tel 01453 544883 or email [brs@janet-crompton.com](mailto:brs@janet-crompton.com))

- If arriving on Tuesday evening, collect your key and parking permit from the relevant reception. Please note that the accommodation in the Glen Eyre Complex is in South Hill and Hartley Grove (see [map](#)), but the reception is ½ mile away in the centre of the Glen Eyre Complex. We suggest you drive to reception first (there is short-term parking outside reception) to check in before driving back to the car park adjacent to Hartley Grove and South Hill. **Please walk to the conference site on Wednesday and Thursday** (10-12 min).
- If arriving on Wednesday morning, please drive to your Hall of Residence. You will not be able to get your room keys yet, but you will need to get a parking permit from Reception before you can leave your car. If staying at Glen Eyre, please take note of above. **Please walk to the conference site on Wednesday and Thursday.**

### **For non-residential delegates**
