**By air**

**Southampton Airport** - Southampton has its own international airport. There are flights to most UK airports (Aberdeen, Belfast, Edinburgh, Glasgow, Leeds, Liverpool, Manchester, Newcastle) as well as several European destinations (Amsterdam, Brussels, Dublin, Paris). From the airport, Highfield Campus is only a short taxi ride away or you can catch the University's Uni-link bus service (for maps and timetables please see the University website at [www.soton.ac.uk](http://www.soton.ac.uk)).

**By train**

Fast trains from London and Bournemouth/ Weymouth stop at Southampton Central and Southampton Airport Parkway. Trains from Portsmouth and Bristol/South Wales stop at Southampton Central. There are taxi ranks at both stations.

Buses to the Highfield Campus (Interchange):

- At Southampton Central, use the south side (platform 4) exit for the Uni-link U1A bus service.
- At Southampton Airport, exit on the airport side of the station for the Uni-link U1C bus service to the Highfield Campus interchange (for maps and timetables please see the University website at [www.soton.ac.uk](http://www.soton.ac.uk)).

**Day Delegates - by road to Hampton Car Park**

**By Car via M3 –**

Follow signs for Southampton A33 (not Southampton Docks).  
Follow the A33 (Bassett Ave.) through 2 roundabouts to a major intersection (with the University's Biological Sciences building to your left).  
Turn left at the lights into Burgess Road  
Continue through two sets of traffic lights  
Turn right into Broadlands Road  
Hampton Car Park is on your left

**By Car via M27 –**

Take junction 5 (Southampton Airport / Eastleigh)  
If coming from the east, take the 1st exit off the roundabout; if coming from the west, take the 4th exit  
Follow the A335 dual carriageway through 2 sets of traffic lights  
At the 3rd set, turn right onto Burgess Road (McDonald's will be on your left)  
Continue through one set of traffic lights  
Turn left into Broadlands Road  
Hampton Car Park is on your left.

**Resident Delegates - by road to Highfield Hall**

**By Car via M3 –**

Follow signs for Southampton A33  
Keep following the A33 (Bassett Avenue), keep in left hand lane  
Go straight over the next two roundabouts  
Continue through traffic lights at a major intersection (with the University's Medical and Biological Sciences building to your left)

Turn left at next set of traffic lights into Highfield Avenue  
Turn 1st right into Nile Road, and Highfield Hall is at the end of the road, directly in front of you

### **Resident Delegates - by road to Highfield Hall**

#### **By Car via M27 –**

Use Junction 5 (Southampton Airport/Eastleigh)  
Coming from East, take 1st exit off roundabout; Coming from West, take 4th exit  
Follow the A335 dual carriageway through 2 sets of traffic lights; at the 3rd set, the road divides  
Turn right onto Burgess Road (McDonald's will be on your left)  
Go through three sets of traffic lights (do not turn into University Road) then turn left at the major intersection onto The Avenue  
Turn left at next set of traffic lights into Highfield Avenue  
Turn 1st right into Nile Road, and Highfield Hall is at the end of the road, directly in front of you

### **Resident Delegates - by road to Glen Eyre Hall**

#### **By Car via M3 –**

Follow signs for Southampton A33 (not Southampton Docks)  
Follow the A33 (Bassett Avenue) through 2 roundabouts to a major intersection (with the University's Biological Sciences building on your left)  
Turn left onto Burgess Road then 2nd left into Glen Eyre Road  
Turn left at the mini roundabout  
The entrance to Glen Eyre Complex (main reception) is about 400 yards on the right hand side – just after the Royal Mail Post Box

### **Resident Delegates - by road to Glen Eyre Hall**

#### **By Car via M27 –**

Exit at Junction 5 (Southampton Airport/ Eastleigh)  
Coming from east, take 1st exit off roundabout; Coming from west, take 4th exit  
Follow the A335 dual carriageway through 2 sets of traffic lights - at the 3rd set, the road divides  
Turn right onto Burgess Road (McDonald's will be on your left)  
Straight through the first set of traffic lights and straight ahead again at the second set (do not turn into University Road)  
Once through the lights get into the right hand lane and turn right into Glen Eyre Road at the next set of lights  
Turn left at the mini roundabout  
The entrance to Glen Eyre Complex (main reception) is about 400 yards on the right hand side – just after the Royal Mail Post Box

### **Car parking**

Parking at Halls of Residence is free of charge but you must display a permit, which can be collected from Halls Reception when you check-in.

Parking at Highfield Campus is free of charge but very limited. Permits are available from the registration desk in the Staff Social Centre.
